## What We've Achieved Together

### Transforming Our Water System

✔ Secured a historic **\$800 million federal investment** for Jackson's water system through persistent advocacy and partnership efforts.

### Investing in Infrastructure & Transportation

✔ **Repaved more roads than previous administrations combined**, including major thoroughfares like Terry Road, Meadowbrook Road, Medgar Evers Boulevard, Northside Drive, and State Street.

✔ **Beginning the repaving of neighborhood streets** using allocated funds to address high-priority projects identified by homeowner associations.

✔ **Completed a full overhaul of JTRAN**, providing **new energy-efficient buses, upgraded bus shelters, expanded routes, and a fresh new brand** for public transit.

✔ Established the **Real-Time Command Center** with cutting-edge policing tools to enhance crime detection, prevention, and response.

✔ Installed **over 100 new street cameras** and expanded personnel at the command center for improved crime-fighting efficiency.

✔ Upgraded law enforcement with **body cameras** and replaced outdated patrol cars with a modern fleet.

✔ Created the **Office of Violence Prevention and Trauma Recovery**, collaborating with community organizations to address root causes of crime.

### Strengthening Our Communities

✔ Hired **11 new code enforcement officers** and partnered with New Way Mississippi for city-wide cleanup efforts.

✔ **Finalizing a deal with MDOC to reestablish inmate cleanup programs** to help maintain a cleaner city.

✔ Eliminated **health insurance premiums** on city employees' paychecks.

✔ Launched **millions in investments for Grove Park revitalization**.

✔ Reopened and upgraded **Pete Brown Golf Course**, with youth camps and women's golf

programs.

✔ Developed Jackson's **first-ever disc golf course** at Livingston Park, where an amphitheater is also being built.

### **Boosting Jackson's Attractions & Economy**

✔ Initiated the **renovation and modernization of the Jackson Planetarium**, making it a one-of-a-kind attraction in our region.

✔ Established an **adopt-an-animal program** between the Jackson Zoo and JPS high schools and restored the annual Ice Cream Safari event.

### **Fighting Blight & Revitalizing Neighborhoods**

✔ Created **Jackson's first-ever commercial demolition budget**, leading to the removal of long-standing blighted properties like Casa Grande Apartments, Hotel O, and Ellis Avenue hotels.
